This is an open minor. Students may declare the major at any time by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

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30 Credits – <u>Language Courses</u>

Complete the 1st and 2nd - year series (15 cr each):

- 1st -year: ASL 101, 102, and 103 <u>OR</u> ASL 134*
- 2nd -year: ASL 201, 202, and 203 <u>OR</u> ASL 234*

*Intensive courses cover a year of material in one quarter.

11-13 Credits – <u>Required Courses</u>

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Students must take ASL 305; LING 400, LING 461, or SPHSC 303 (if student already took it); and LING 403.

7+ Credits – Elective Courses

 Students must take at least 7 credits from:

 LING courses other than LING 400/461.

 ASL 301, 302, 303, 306, 334, 495, 499

 AES 332, 340, 389
 ANTH 301, 359, 376, 464, 471

 COM 374
 DIS ST 332, 346, 433, 434

50 Credits with the following requirements:

- At least 18 credits of the ASL minor cannot overlap with your major requirements.
- Students must earn a minimum 2.0 GPA in all classes applied to the minor.
