MINOR GUIDE – ASIAN LANGUAGES & CULTURES

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

+

15 Credits – Primary Language Courses

Complete second-year (200-level) or above in one of the following Asian languages: Bengali, Chinese, Hindi, Indonesian, Japanese, Korean, Sanskrit, Urdu, Vietnamese.

15 Credits – Language, <u>Literature, Culture & Linguistics Courses</u>

10 credits must not be a language course.

5 credits can be from classes outside of the Asian Languages & Literatures department.

=

30 Credits minimum with the following requirements:

- 15 credits must be at the 300-level or above.
- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
