

# MAJOR GUIDE – CHINESE

## DECLARING THE MAJOR

This is a minimum requirements major. Students who have taken 20+ credits of college-level Chinese coursework, have received a 2.5 or higher in their most recent Chinese course, have received a 2.0 or higher in a W course, and have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher may declare the major by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

## PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

### **25 Credits – Core Courses**

Complete CHIN 451, 452, 462, 463, and 342\*

\*CHIN 442 can be an alternative if necessary.

+

### **15-20 Credits – Language Courses**

Complete through one of the following:  
CHIN 212 (heritage) or CHIN 303 (non-heritage).

If incoming proficiency is beyond CHIN 212/303, use the following to fill the credit deficit: CHIN 411, 412, 413, 445, 470, and/or 482. CHIN 496 or I BUS 490 can be used if the topic is advanced language.

### **5-10 Credits – Secondary Electives**

ASIAN 201, 204, 207, 211, 263 (when topic is China)  
CHIN 373, 374, 380, 381, 385, 443, 453, 463

**50 Credits** minimum with the following requirements:

- A maximum of 20 credits of language courses may count towards the major.
- A maximum of 10 credits can be taken outside the Asian Languages & Literatures department.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained in all classes counting towards the major.
