

# MINOR GUIDE – CHINESE

## DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

## PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

### **15 Credits – Language Courses**

Students must complete up to CHIN 213 (heritage) or CHIN 303 (non-heritage).

400-level language classes may count towards the minor, but 100 and 200-level classes do not.

### **15 Credits – Linguistics, Literature, Culture and/or Classical Language**

Must include the following classes:

1. CHIN 342 or CHIN 442
2. CHIN 461 or CHIN 463

Electives include:

ASAIN 201, 204, 207, 211, 263  
CHIN 373, 374, 380, 381, 385, 443, 453, 462

=

**30 Credits** minimum with the following requirements:

- 15 credits must be at the 300-level or above.
- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
- All classes must be within the Asian Languages & Literature department.
