DECLARING THE MAJOR

This is a minimum requirements major. Students who have completed one CMS prerequisite course, an English Composition course or Writing course, and have an cumulative GPA of a 2.00 or above may declare the major by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

5 Credits – Prerequisite Course

Choose one of the following: CMS 270, 271, 272, 273, 274, 275

+

30 Credits – Core Courses

The following two courses are required:

- Gateway Course: CMS 301
- Capstone Course: CMS 480

Select one from each of the following categories:

- History 1: CMS 310 or 311
- History 2: CMS 312, 313, 314, or 315
- Critical Concepts 1: CMS 302, 303, or 304
- Critical Concepts 2: CMS 320 or 321

+

30 Credits – Elective Courses

At least 20 credits must be at/above the 300-level.

At least 10 credits must be CMS courses from this list: CMS 297, 301, 302, 303, 310, 312, 313, 320, 370, 397, 443, 470, 497
