DECLARING THE MAJOR

This is an open major. Students with good academic standing may declare it at any time by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

10-15 Credits – Introductory Language Courses

Students may choose to focus in either Latin or Greek to complete one of the following series:

- GREEK/LATIN 101, 102, and 103
- GREEK/LATIN 300 and 103

2-3 Credits – Senior Essay

Completing CLAS 495 following these conditions:

- Essay written during last year of study in conjunction with another course.
- 7-10 pages of text must be written per credit awarded.

15 Credits – Intermediate Language Courses

Students may choose to focus on either Latin or Greek to satisfy the following language series:
