## DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

## PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

### 30 Credits – Elective Course

CLAS 210, 320, 322, 324, 326, 328, 329, 330, 335,

GREEK 300/400 level courses *except* 300 and 301

LATIN 300/400 level courses *except* 300, 301, 401,

HSTAM 205, 302, 312, 313, 314, 330, 335, 401, 402,  
403, 420, 490\*\*

HIST 320, HSTRY 498\*\*

\*only when topic is *not* medieval    \*\*only when topic is ancient

**30 Credits** minimum with the following requirements:

- A minimum of 20 credits must be taken at the 300-level or above, 15 of which must be taken at UW.
- At least 20 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
- 100-level courses cannot apply.
- Students cannot complete this with any other major or minor in the Classics department.
