

# MAJOR GUIDE – FRENCH

## DECLARING A MAJOR

This is an open major. Students with good academic standing may declare it at any time by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

## PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

### **15 Credits – Advanced Language Courses**

Students must complete through the following series: FRENCH 301, 302, and 303

French 301 and 302 can be taken in any order, but completion of one is required for French 303.

### **10 Credits – 400-Level Courses**

Any 400-level courses can apply.

### **5 Credits – 370 Course**

Choose one of the following:

FRENCH 373, 374, 376, 378, 379

+

### **20 Credits – Elective Courses**

Any class above FRENCH 203 may apply. Electives can be taken outside of the French & Italian department with adviser approval.

+

= **50 Credits** with the following requirements:

- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the major.
- Up to 15 credits taken through Study Abroad can apply to the major.
