FRENCH 203, 301, 302, and 303

FRENCH 203 must be taken before FRENCH 301 or 302. FRENCH 301 and 302 do not have to be taken in sequence. Taking either FRENCH 301 or FRENCH 302 is required to take FRENCH 303, but not both.
