## DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

## PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

### 10 Credits - Required Courses

German 203 and German 311

### 20 Credits - Elective Courses

Any combination of the following can be taken. No more than 10 credits can be taken at the 200 level:

### 5 Credits - 400-level Coursework

Any of the following: GERMAN 411, 412, 421, 422, 423, 490, 493, 494, 495, 497, 498, 499

### 35 Credits with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
