

MAJOR GUIDE – JAPANESE

DECLARING A MAJOR

This is a minimum requirements major. Students who have completed at least 20 credits of college-level coursework in Japanese with the most recent grade of 2.5 or higher, one W course with a grade of 2.00 or higher, and have a cumulative UW GPA of 2.5 or higher can declare the major by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

15-20 Credits – Language Courses

Students must complete through JAPAN 303.

Students without previous experience should take the following series:

- JAPAN 101, 102, and 103
- JAPAN 201, 202, and 203
- JAPAN 301, 302, and 303

Students with previous experience must earn up to 15 credits from the following:

- Advanced Series: JAPAN 401, 402, and 403
- Other courses: JAPAN 411, 412, 413, 418, 431, 432, 433, 445, 451, 543, 452, 471, 472

30-35 Credits – Elective Courses

All classes must be taken at the 300-level or above. At least one class must be at the 400-level.

Approved 300-level electives include the following:
JAPAN 321, 322, 325, 343, 344, 360, 361, 380, 395

Approved 400-level electives include the following:
431, 432, 433, 434, 435, 441, 442, 443, 460, 461, 471, 472, 473, 499

5 credits may come from outside of the Department of Asian Languages & Literature.
