MINOR GUIDE – JAPANESE

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

15 Credits – Language Study

Students must complete up to JAPAN 303. Any of the following 300 and 400-level classes may apply to this section of the minor:

JAPAN 301, 302, 303, 304, 334, 343, 345 JAPAN 401, 411, 412, 413, 418, 431, 432, 433, 445, 451, 452, 471, 472

No 100 or 200-level language classes may count towards the minor.

15 Credits – Japanese Humanities Courses

+ JAPAN 321, 322, 323, 325, 342, 343, 344, 360, 361, 380, 434, 435, 440, 441, 442, 443, 460, 461

Classes must be at the 300-level or higher to count towards this requirement.

30 Credits minimum with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
- All classes must be within the Asian Languages & Literature department.
