

# MAJOR GUIDE – KOREAN

## DECLARING A MAJOR

This is a minimum requirements major. Students who have completed at least 20 credits of college-level coursework in Korean with the most recent grade of 2.5 or higher, one W course with a grade of 2.00 or higher, and have a cumulative UW GPA of 2.5 or higher can declare the major by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

## PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

### **15-20 Credits – Language Courses**

Students must complete through KOREAN 303.

Students without previous experience should take the following series:

- KOREAN 101, 102, and 103
- KOREAN 201, 202, and 203
- KOREAN 301, 302, and 303

Students with previous experience can fulfill credits with the Reading in Korean Literature series:

- KOREAN 415, 416, 417

### **30-35 Credits – Area-Related Humanities & Social Sciences Courses**

All classes must be taken at the 300-level or above.
