

MINOR GUIDE – KOREAN

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

15 Credits – Language Study

Students must complete up to KOREAN 303. Any of the following 300 and 400-level classes may apply to this section of the minor:

Korean 301, 302, and 303
Korean 415, 416, and 417
Korean 345: Study Abroad in Advanced Korean

No 100 or 200-level language classes may count towards the minor.

Classes must be at the 300-level or higher to count towards this requirement.

30 Credits minimum with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
- All classes must be within the Asian Languages & Literature department.
