

MINOR GUIDE – LINGUISTICS

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

10 Credits – Introductory Courses

Pick two courses from the following groups:

1. LING 200, LING 203/ANTH 203, LING 400
2. ASIAN 401, ENGL 370, FREN 323, GERMAN 451, JAPAN 440, SLAVIC 110, SPAN 323, SPHSC 303

+

15 Credits – Core Courses

Any three from LING 432, 450*, 451, 461*, 462, 478, 481.

*Recommended courses by the department

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12 Credits – Elective Courses

6 of the 12 credits must be upper-division, with the exception of LING 220 and 270. Cannot overlap with core courses or language requirements.

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30 Credits with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR COLLEGE OF EDUCATION STUDENTS

Upper division language courses (2.0 minimum grade in each course)

5 Credits

History/Culture Class in Chosen Language

+

One Course

Pedagogical Methods For Chosen Language (2.0 minimum)

Proficiency Exam

Department-specific. May substitute 15 credits of upper division language classes.
