

# MAJOR GUIDE – LINGUISTICS

## DECLARING THE MAJOR

This is a minimum-requirements major. Students must complete their world language requirements, one W course/an additional Composition course, an introductory Linguistics course, and an additional QSR course, earning a 2.0 minimum GPA in all courses and a cumulative GPA of 2.50 in the W, Introductory, and QSR courses. Once these have been completed, students can meet with a HAS adviser at any time to declare the major.

## PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

### **5 Credits – Introductory Courses**

Students must take one of the following for admittance into the major:  
LING 200, LING/ANTH 203, LING 400 (preferred)  
ASIAN 401, ENGL 370, FREN 323, GERMAN 451,  
JAPAN 440, SLAVIC 110, SPAN 323, SPHSC 303

+

### **30 Credits – Language Courses**

One year each (or the equivalent) of two languages, one of which must belong to a family of languages different from the student's own native language. A student may test out of one language, but not both. For full details, see the [Language Requirement page](#).

### **25 Credits – Core Courses**

Students must take all of the following:  
+ Ling 450, LING 451, LING 461, LING 462, one LING 4XX course (excludes LING 400, 419, 430, 480, 490, 499)

+

### **20 Credits – Elective Courses**

+ Any upper division LING course that is not an introductory course or a course used to fulfill other requirements may be applied.

= **65+ Credits** with the following requirements:

- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the major.
