DECLARING A MAJOR

This is an open major. Students who are in good academic standing may declare the major at any time by setting up an appointment with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

15 Credits – Required NEAR E Courses

Students must take the following courses:

- NEAR E 101
- NEAR E 201
- NEAR E 202

+

2 Credits – Senior Seminar

Complete this by taking NEAR E 491.

Students must complete this during the last Autumn Quarter of the program.

+

30 Credits – Biblical Hebrew Courses

Students must take both of the following series:

- BIBHEB 101, 102, and 103 OR BIBHEB 105
- BIBHEB 201, 202, and 203

Placement/proficiency tests can be used to surpass certain/all levels. BIBHEB 105 is only available during summer and covers BIBHEB 101-103.

25 Credits – Upper Division Courses

The following will count towards this requirement:

- Advanced Literature: 300/400-level courses with the NEAR E or language prefixes
- Other language courses (15 credit limit)
- Approved relevant exceptions (15 credit limit)

=

72 Credits with the following requirements:

- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the major.
- 22 credits must be taken in-residence at the Middle Eastern Languages and Civilization Department.
