

MINOR GUIDE – MIDDLE EASTERN LANGUAGES AND CULTURE

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser. Students with a major in the Middle Eastern Languages & Civilization department may declare a minor in Middle Eastern Languages and Cultures, but only 60% of the coursework applied to the minor can overlap with the major.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

5 Credits – Gateway Course

NEAR E 101

+

10 Credits – Introductory Courses

Any 200-level course with the NEAR E prefix will count towards this requirement.

+

15 Credits – NEAR E Or Advanced Language Courses

Language courses cannot be taken at the elementary (100) or intermediate (200) level.

=

30 Credits with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be at the 300-level or above.
- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
