

MINOR GUIDE – PERSIAN

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser. Students with a major in the Middle Eastern Languages & Civilization department may declare a minor in Persian, but only 60% of the coursework applied to the minor can overlap with the major.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

10 Credits – Upper Division Courses With the PRSAN Prefix

PRSAN 401, 402, 403, 404, 405, 406, 454, 455, 456, 490, 496, 499

+

15 Credits – Persian Language Courses

PRSAN 201, 202, and 203

Students with language proficiency beyond the 2nd-year series (from test, high school, native speaker, etc.) should take 20 credits of upper-division courses with the PRSAN prefix and earn 10 credits of electives.

+

5 Credits – Elective Coursework

Any upper-division PRSAN course
NEAR E 101, 234, 243, 244, 286, 343, 344, 345, 392, 429

=

30 Credits with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be at the 300-level or above.
- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
