

MINOR GUIDE – RUSSIAN LANGUAGE

DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

15 Credits – 200-Level Language Courses

RUSS 201, 202, and 203

Students with proficiency within or beyond the 2nd-year series (from test, high school, native speaker, etc.) should take additional elective classes to reach the 25-credit requirement.

+

10 Credits – Elective Courses

RUSS 301, 302, 303, 313, 314, 316, 350, 350, 401, 402, 403, 450, 451, 481

SLAVIC 110, 210, 351, 425, 426, 470

=

25 Credits minimum with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits must be at the 300-level or above.
- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
