DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

6-15 Credits – Second-Year Language Courses

Completion of one of the following East European Languages:

BCMS 404, 405, and 406
BULGR 404, 405, and 406
CZECH 404, 405, and 406
POLSH 404, 405, and 406
SLVN 404 and 406
UKR 404, 405, and 406

Students with proficiency within or beyond the 2nd-year series (from test, high school, native speaker, etc.) should take additional elective classes to reach the 25-credit requirement.

19-25* Credits – Elective Courses

SLAVIC 101, 110, 130, 210, 351, 370, 425426, 470

*Amount varies depending on language of study. See Language Courses box to left.

25 Credits minimum with the following requirements:

- At least 15 credits must be at the 300-level or above.
- At least 15 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
