## DECLARING THE MAJOR

This is minimum requirements major. Students who have 20+ credits of college coursework in the primary language of concentration, received a 2.5 GPA or above in their most recent primary language class, and have completed one W course with a 2.0 GPA or above may declare the major by meeting with a Humanities Academic Services adviser.
