

# MAJOR GUIDE – SPANISH

## DECLARING A MAJOR

This is a minimum requirements major. Students who have completed SPAN 203, have a GPA of 2.7 for all Spanish coursework (no individual grades below 2.5), have received a 2.5 GPA in a writing class, and have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher may declare the major by meeting with an adviser at Humanities Academic Services.

## PATHWAY TO THE MAJOR

### **15 Credits – Language Courses**

Students must complete one of the following series:

1. SPAN 301, 302, and 303 (non-heritage learners)
2. SPAN 314, 315, and 316 (heritage learners)

### **15 Credits – Literature, Culture, and Linguistics Courses**

Students must complete all the following:

- SPAN 321
- SPAN 322
- SPAN 323

+

### **10 Credits – Upper-Division Courses**

3-5 credits from the following 300-level courses on literature:

SPAN 304, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 319, 336, 339, 340, 350, 351, 352, 394, 395

25 credits from any 400-level course.

+

### **Variable Credits – Experiential Learning**

Students may complete this in one of two ways:

1. 1+ quarter of an approved study abroad program in a Spanish-speaking country.
2. 2 quarters of service learning through SPAN 392. 1 credit/30 hours of learning.

**58 Credits** with the following requirements:

- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the major.
