DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

PATHWAY TO THE MINOR

15 Credits – Advanced Language Courses

One of the following series: SPAN 301, 302, and 303 SPAN 314, 315, and 316 (Heritage Learners only)

12+ Credits – <u>Elective Courses</u>

- + At least four classes at the 300 or 400-level must be taken to fulfill this requirement and bring the total credits up to 27.
- = **27 Credits** minimum with the following requirements:
 - Only one course that is primarily taught in English may apply to the minor.
 - SPAN 327 and 499 cannot apply to the minor.
 - At least 20 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
 - A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
