## DECLARING A MINOR

Students with good academic standing who have declared a major in any department and have completed 45 credits at the University of Washington may declare a minor by setting up an appointment with their major adviser.

### **10 Credits – Approved Theory, History & Design Courses**

**25 Credits** minimum with the following requirements:

- 20 credits must be at the 300-level or above.
- No more than five credits may be from Creative Writing courses.
- No 100-level courses may count towards the minor.
- ENGL 295 and 491 cannot be applied to the minor.
- At least 20 credits applied to the minor must be taken in residency at UW.
- A 2.00 GPA must be maintained among all courses applied to the minor.
